### **Privacy Policy**

This Statement of Privacy applies to KRolland.net ("Site") and The Rolland Group, Inc. ("RGI"), a Florida corporation, and governs data collection and usage. For the purposes of this Privacy Policy, unless otherwise noted, all references to RGI or the Site include Kenneth B Rolland & Karen S Rolland, owners of RGI and the Site.

Protecting your private information is a major priority for RGI.

By accessing or using the Site you consent to the data practices in this statement. Should you not consent to the data practices in this statement, you do not have RGI's permission to access or use the Site.

#### **Collection of your Personal Information**

In order to better provide you with information and services offered on the Site, RGI may collect personally identifiable information, such as your:

- First and Last Name(s)
- Mailing Address(es)
- E-mail Address(es)
- Phone Number(s)

and other information voluntarily provided by you in any of the comment fields available on the Site.

RGI does not collect any personal information about you unless you voluntarily provide it. However, you may be required to provide certain personal information when you elect to use certain features or services available on the Site. These may include: (a) registering for an account on the Site; (b) entering a sweepstakes or contest sponsored by RGI or one of its partners; (c) signing up for special offers from selected third parties; (d) sending RGI an email message. To wit, RGI will use your information for, but not limited to, communicating with you in relation to information or services you have requested from RGI. RGI also may gather additional personal or non-personal information in the future.

#### **Use of your Personal Information**

RGI collects and uses your personal information to operate its website(s) and deliver the information and services you have requested.

RGI may also use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other information or services available from RGI and selected third parties.

#### **Sharing Information with Third Parties**

RGI does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties.

RGI may share personal information with selected third parties to perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail or provide customer support. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to RGI, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

RGI may disclose your personal information, without notice, if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on RGI or the Site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of RGI; and/or (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of the Site or the public.

### **Tracking User Behavior**

RGI may keep track of the websites and pages RGI's users visit within or through links on the Site in order to determine which RGI services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

### **Automatically Collected Information**

Information about your computer hardware and software may be automatically collected by RGI. This information can include: your IP address, browser type, domain names, access times and referring website addresses. This information is used for the operation of the service, to maintain quality of the service, and to provide general statistics regarding use of the Site.

### **Use of Cookies**

The Site may use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. Typically this means that it will tell the web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize pages on the Site or register with the Site for services, a cookie helps the Site recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, email addresses, shipping addresses and so on. When you return to the Site, the information you previously provided can be retrieved so you can easily use the features of the Site that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the RGI services or websites you visit.

If you choose to stop receiving marketing or promotional communications via email from RGI, you may opt out of such communications by clicking on the UNSUBSCRIBE button.

RGI will notify you about significant changes in the way RGI treats personal information by sending a notice to the primary email address specified in your account, by placing a prominent notice on the Site, and/or by updating any privacy information on this page. Your continued use of the Site and/or services available through this Site after such modifications will constitute your: (a) acknowledgment of the modified Privacy Policy; and (b) agreement to abide and be bound by that Policy.
